

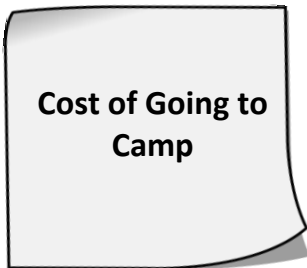


# St. Brigid's Summer Camp

St. Brigid's Summer Camp believes that every child should have the opportunity to attend camp regardless of their family's financial situation. **As a registered charity, we do not charge any fees to attend camp. Instead, we rely on the financial support of those in the community who believe in the quality experience that St. Brigid's Summer Camp has been providing to children and youth from all walks of life since 1972.**

Last year, we spent \$430,000 to provide camp holidays to nearly 1,000 children from Ottawa and the surrounding area. In preparation for another camp season, we need to raise more than **\$400 for each camper** who attends and **\$700 for each L.I.T. participant**.

## What to Pack

Label Your Stuff!

### Bedding

- sleeping bag
- pillow

### Clothing

- t-shirts
- shorts
- long pants
- long sleeved shirt
- sweater
- jacket/rain jacket
- socks
- underwear
- pajamas
- bathing suit
- swimming t-shirt** (not tank top)
- 2 hats** (not sun visors)
- sandals
- running shoes
- extra pair of running shoes, in case one gets wet
- rain boots, if a rainy week is forecast

### Personal Items

- toothbrush
- toothpaste
- hairbrush/comb
- body soap
- facecloth
- towel
- sunblock > SPF 25
- insect repellent

### Other Items

- water bottle
- flashlight

### What NOT to Pack

- x junk food
  - x Spitz/sunflower seeds
  - x food containing nuts
  - x cell phone
  - x iPods/mp3 player
  - x knives/weapons
  - x money
  - x anything valuable
- If you are afraid to lose it, don't bring it!*

**Do not pack medication in your child's luggage. Give it to the designated staff member at the bus stop.**



- Clearly label medication with your child's name and dosage requirements.
- Keep medication in the original container.
- Check the expiry date.
